




Community Overview

Decorah is the county seat and largest community of Winneshiek County, located at the intersection of State Highway 9 and U.S. Route 52.

Decorah is a warm and vibrant town that offers plentiful recreation, a charming downtown, natural beauty, and a close-knit community—all while providing the conveniences of a city many times its size. Decorah has become a center for Norwegian-American culture, including an annual festival celebrating the Norwegian culture and home of the Vesterheim Museum - the largest museum in the country dedicated to one single immigrant group. Decorah is a popular destination in northeast lowa, featuring numerous outdoor recreation, events and festivals, and a pedestrian-friendly town center full of niche eateries and shops. The Upper Iowa River flows through Luther College campus and borders Decorah's business district, with the Trout Run Trail, an 11-mile biking, walking, and running trail that loops the town.
